

# Milwaukee Voter Registration Program

*Easy, effective way to add new Democratic voters in this pivotal swing state*

We have found a way to register as many as 10,000 Wisconsin Democrats and talk with over 25,000 voters by the 2020 election. We have over 60 volunteers already, but we need more!

We have joined forces with local Milwaukee residents who have been registering Wisconsin voters for over 10 years at DMV offices in highly Democratic areas.

It is a perfect environment ... indoors, clean, and with a restroom! And, there are plenty of potential voters; they have their IDs with them, and they are just sitting and waiting.

We provide simple training and all the materials you need. No technology involved! Only a 90-minute drive from northern Chicagoland.

Election experts have told us this is – by far - the most effective voter registration effort they know of.

## **How to Get Involved**

1. Sign-up for mandatory training sessions at the link below. Maximum of three volunteers per session. You can meet Bob Best or Linda Tate at the training site in Milwaukee or they will drive trainees up to Milwaukee from their apartment building in downtown Evanston. Car leaves at 9am, stopping at the Lake Forest Oasis if someone wants to be picked up there. Training/registering from 11am to 2pm. Return to Evanston before 4pm.

2. After volunteers are trained, they will be able to sign up for on-going registration sessions. A special link to a Sign-Up Genius site will be provided.

## **Why Are We Being Discrete?**

Republicans in Wisconsin realize that having more voters works against them, so they are doing everything they can to suppress voter registration and turnout.

Our registration program is so effective that we fear if the Republicans get wind of it, they will try to shut it down. This happened once before, and the program was suspended for months.

So, we are not identifying the exact location outside of the volunteers who participate in the training. Participants must commit not to communicate program details to anyone else.
